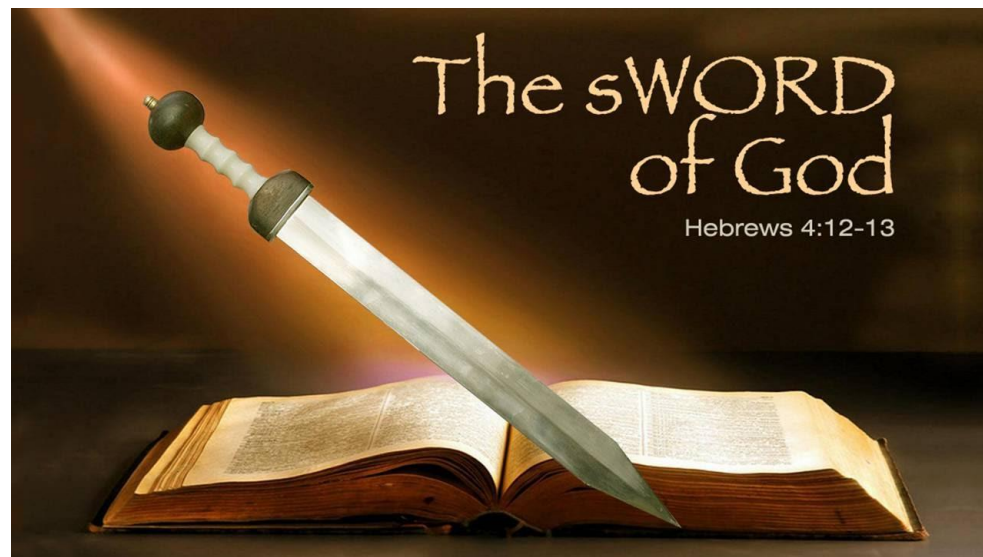
Sunday August 28th Backpack Blessing
