Also the collection of the Prairie Farm product caps will continue. Those caps can be left in the brown container at the main doors.

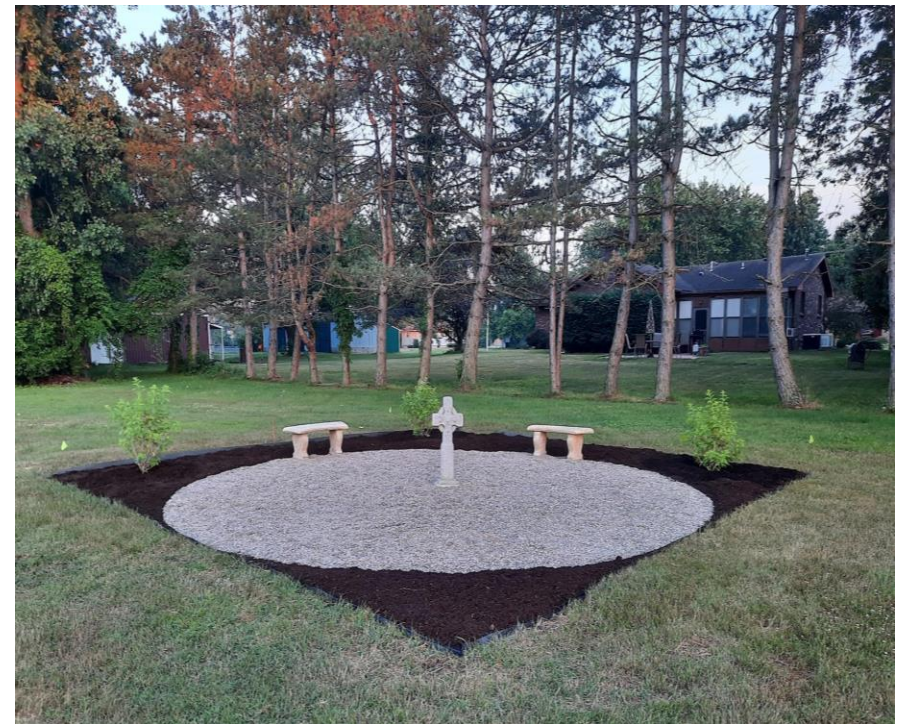
PIANIST NEEDED
