QUILTS OF LOVE

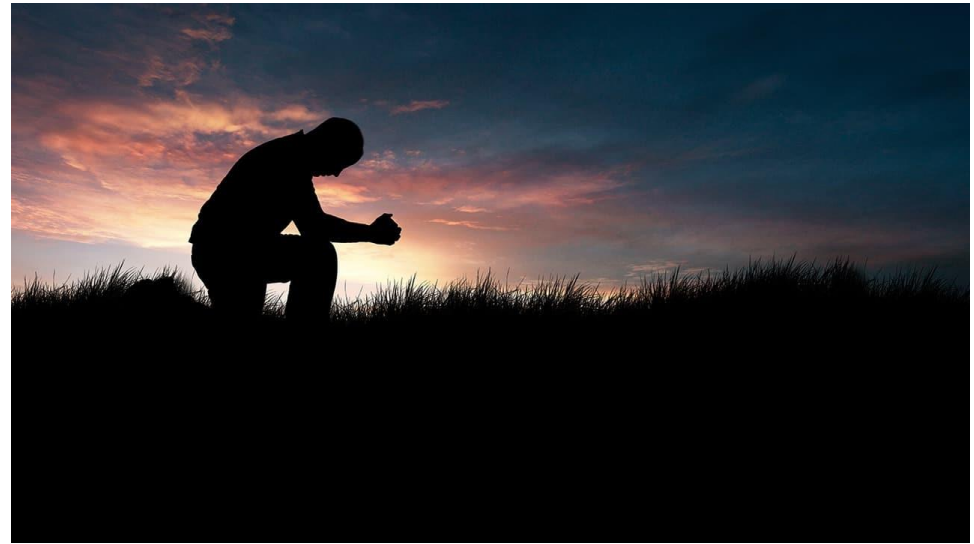
