JUST A REMINDER

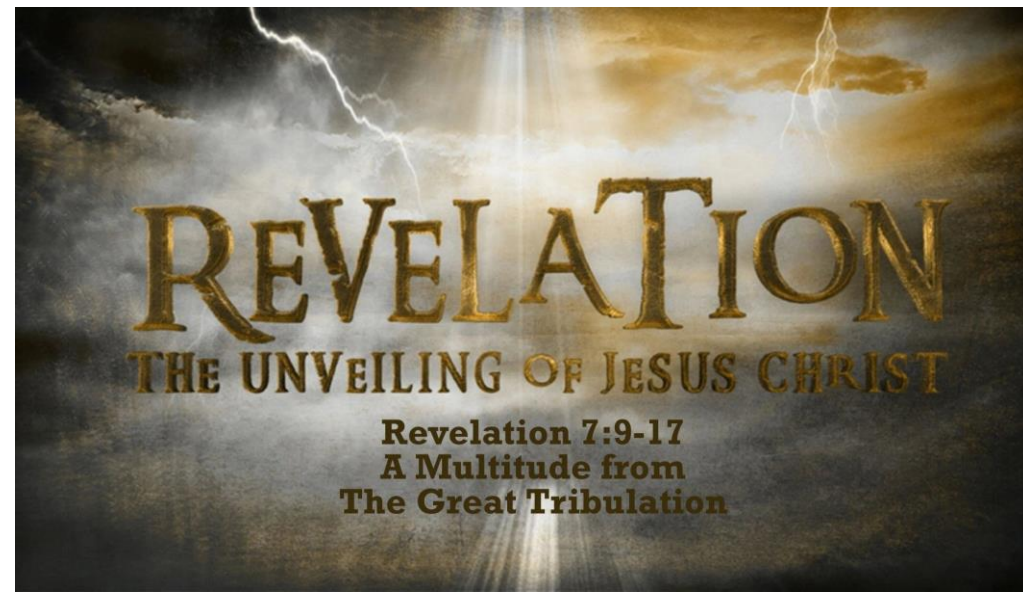
Sunday, Nov. 20th Bible Sunday – submit the names of your third graders to the church office as soon as possible.
