CHRISTMAS CHOIR:

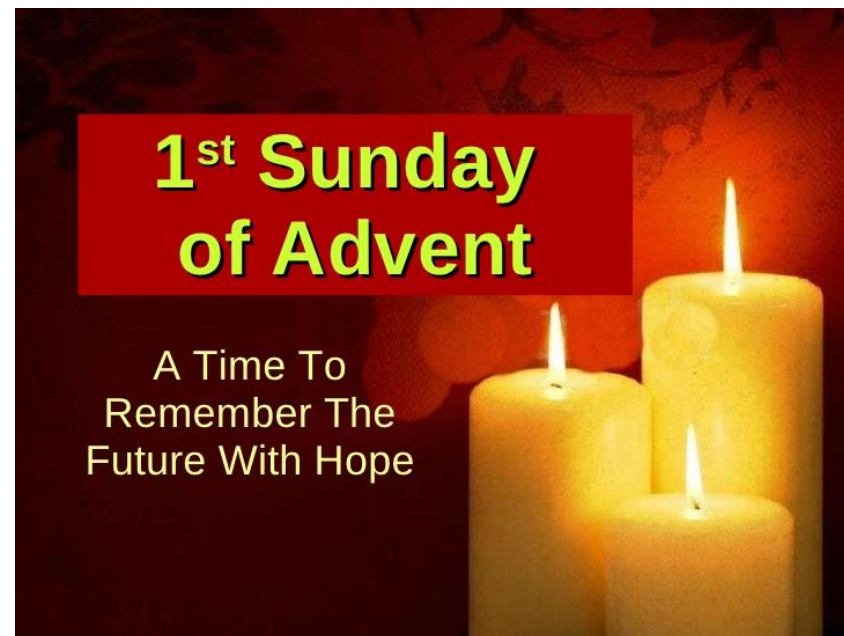
Calling all singers there is a Christmas Choir forming for Christmas Eve. Choir practice will be on Dec. 6th and 20th at 7pm. All are welcome.
