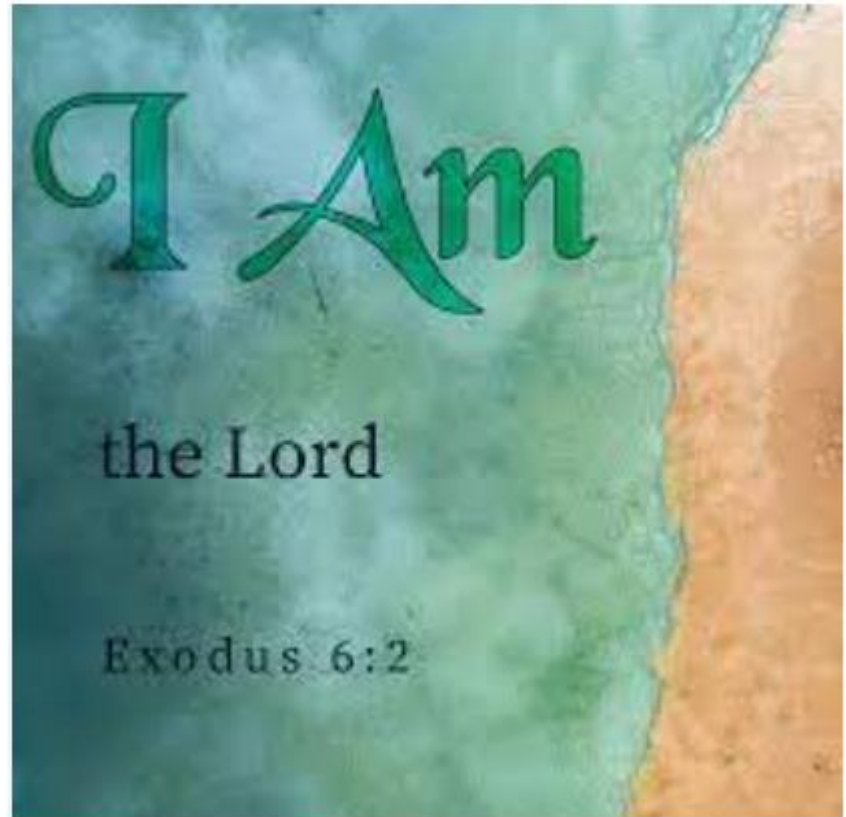
MEMBERSHIP AVAILABLE
