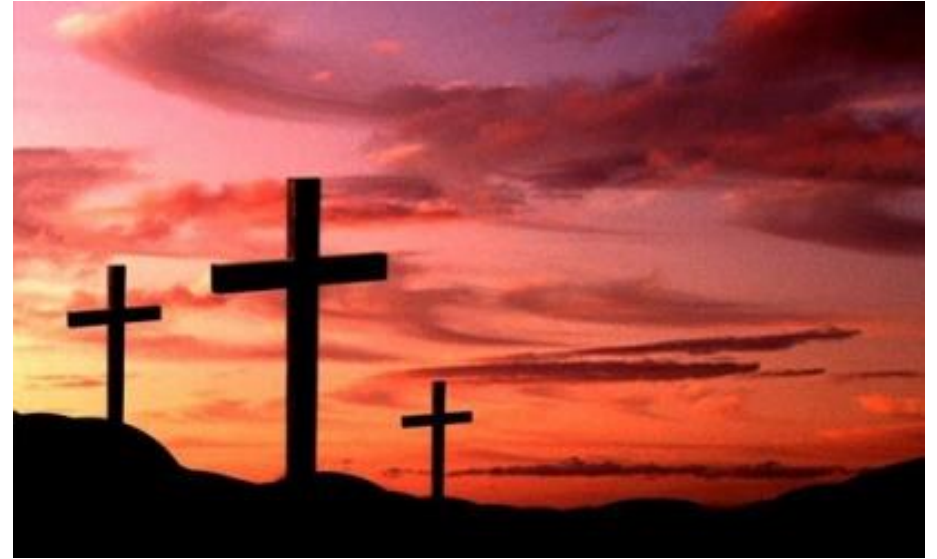


***We Are A Church With A Vision***
